Australia Student Visa Checklist

When applying for your Australia student visa, you will generally need:

- 1. Proof of enrolment (your electronic confirmation of enrolment eCOE)
- 2. A valid passport
- 3. National ID card
- 4. Your visa application fee
- 5. Your Genuine Temporary Entrant (GTE) statement
- 6. Academic and work experience documents
- 7. Evidence of your English proficiency skills (such as IELTS test scores)
- 8. Evidence of financial ability (tuition fees, living expenses, expenses for dependents, return airfare)
 - A. Bank Statement for at least six months
 - B. Bank Solvency Certificate
 - C. Proof of sponsor's sources of income
 - D. Proof of tax payments for the last 2 years
- 9. Details of your health insurance policy (OSHC)
- 10. Passport-sized photographs

If you are under 18 years of age, you will also need to provide additional documents such as parental consent.
